CAMPER BEHAVIOR POLICY

Champion Learning Academy's objective is to provide a safe, fun, and nurturing environment for each camper. In order for each camper to have a positive and enriching experience, Champion Learning Academy staff will provide positive reinforcement and praise as an effective way of managing the behavior of each camper. In the event that negative behavior arises, Champion Learning Academy staff will use the following guidelines:

- **FIRST OCCURRENCE** – Proximity control, nonverbal cue to correct behavior, and/or quiet verbal reprimand;
 - **SECOND OCCURRENCE** – Seat change and/or minor incident slip, parent/guardian contacted;
 - **THIRD OCCURRENCE** – Written incident report to parent/guardian.
- If the offense is severe, including but not limited to, spitting, biting, fighting, theft, vandalism, possession of weapons, alcohol, cigarettes, or illegal substances; or inappropriate language, severe verbal threats, physical aggression, leaving the designated area without permission, or sexual misconduct, the camper will be **IMMEDIATELY** dismissed, bypassing all steps above, and **NO REFUND WILL BE GIVEN. THE ACTIONS TAKEN WILL BE AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CHAMPION LEARNING ACADEMY DIRECTOR.**

CAMPER BEHAVIOR GUIDELINES

1. Campers are expected to abide by the behavior expectations; parents must review the guidelines with their children prior to the start of Track Out/ Summer Camp session.
2. Except when excused by the Champion Learning Academy Director, all campers are expected to remain on campus.
3. All campers should come to camp dressed in appropriate attire – play clothes. Champion Learning Academy offers a variety of physical activities, e.g., soccer and tennis and arts and crafts activities that may involve painting. Therefore, campers should come prepared to participate in these activities by wearing close-toe shoes and casual/play clothes/athletic wear.
4. Champion Learning Academy is a tobacco free campus and, as such, prohibits the use of and distribution of all tobacco products by employees, students, and visitors.
5. Campers are not permitted to possess or use alcoholic beverages or illegal substances on or off campus property. The possession of weapons or explosives of any kind, or objects, tools, or devices that may be used as weapons is prohibited on campus and at any champion Learning Academy program-related activity.
6. Prior to registration, any special physical, emotional, psychological, or medication needs of your child must be identified and, if necessary, discussed with the Champion Learning Academy Director.

REFUND POLICY

- No refunds will be issued after payment is received unless the camper's seat can be filled by the Director of Champion Learning Academy;
- Full/prorated refunds will be provided in the event of a verified medical/hardship situation.

AUTHORIZATIONS

I accept charges for the Tuition & other named Fees. I understand that all Fees are due in advance and are nonrefundable.

I accept financial responsibility for damages incurred by Participant. I accept & agree that I & the Participant must follow all the Rules & Policies of the *Champion Learning Academy Camp*.
